Dedicating a Rock, Bench Seat or a 'Commemorative Plaque' at Bellbrae

Bellbrae Cemetery offers a variety of settings and gravesite options as peaceful resting places for you or your loved one.

In some cases, people may choose to be buried, or have their ashes placed elsewhere. So, often families seek alternative ways to commemorate their loved ones and are simply looking for a place where they can visit to reflect and enjoy special memories.

Dedicating a Rock or Bench Seat or selecting a 'Plaque Only' location may offer a good solution. These options do not include burial or ashes interment rights.

Rock Seats:

Are located in our Eastern Section to complement its natural bush setting.

To acknowledge the dedication, a single bronze plaque (380 x 280mm) may be installed on the front of Rock Seat.

It is important to note, while the seat is dedicated, it always remains available for all visitors to use and enjoy.

Bench Seats:

Are placed at key points throughout the grounds and a single metal plaque may be installed – size & location subject to prior Trust approval.

Plaques:

All plaques must comply with relevant legislation and Australian Standards. They require:

- an application to be completed and approved by the Trust.
- payment of the relevant fee prior to installation.

Temporary plaques made of non-lasting material will be removed after 6 months.

Purchase and installation costs remain the responsibility of the family or individual.
